# Management Discussion of Fund Performance

NOVEMBER 12, 2021

This management discussion of Fund performance presents views of the portfolio management team about the significant factors and developments during the past six months that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook since March 31, 2021, the Fund's most recent fiscal year-end. This report should be read in conjunction with the annual Management Report of Fund Performance for the year ended March 31, 2021.

## Results of Operations

### CHANGES IN NET ASSETS

The Fund's net assets decreased by 8.3% during the period to \$2.0 billion. This change was comprised primarily of gains from operations of \$173.3 million, an increase of \$217.9 million due to mergers with other funds (see *Other Developments*) and a decrease of \$574.7 million due to net securityholder activity.

### FEES AND EXPENSES

The management expense ratios (MERs) for all series are generally similar to the MERs for the 12-month period ended March 31, 2021. Total expenses paid vary period to period mainly as a result of changes in average assets in each series.

### INVESTMENT PERFORMANCE

In accordance with National Instrument 81-106, the following comparison to one or more market indices has been included to help you understand the Fund's performance relative to the general performance of the markets. However, the portfolio management team cautions that the Fund's mandate may be different from the index or indices shown. Also, it is important to note that investors cannot invest in an index. Indirect investments in an index are available; however, there are fees and transaction costs and other variables that will impact returns when investing in these products. Index returns included in the comparison below do not reflect these costs and variables. In addition, unlike the index, this Fund may be subject to valuation adjustments as outlined in the Fund's valuation policies as it relates to non-North American equities held either directly or indirectly by the Fund. A fair value adjustment can either positively or negatively impact the Fund's rate of return.

For the returns of all series and for longer-term performance of the Fund, see the *Past Performance* section of this report. Performance will vary by series primarily because fees and expenses may differ between series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. See *Series Information* for the annual expense rates for each series.

For the six-month period ended September 30, 2021, the Series U securities returned 7.6% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the Fund). In comparison, the S&P/TSX Composite Index (equity index) returned 8.7% and the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index (fixed income index) returned 1.1%.

Canadian equities continued their upward momentum over the period, reaching new highs as ongoing COVID-19 vaccination programs facilitated further economic reopening. The combination of economic reopening and tight supply supported a strong rise in oil prices, benefiting the Canadian energy sector. The Bank of Canada

maintained monetary policy support, including keeping its policy interest rate at 0.25% and making substantial bond purchases. Yields on 10-year Government of Canada bonds increased, reflecting higher-than-expected inflation and signals of a shift to tighter policy from the U.S. Federal Reserve.

Within the S&P/TSX Composite Index, information technology, energy and real estate were the strongest sectors, while health care, consumer discretionary and materials were the weakest.

The equity portion of the Fund outperformed the equity index, with stock selection in the energy and health care sectors contributing to performance. In country terms, stock selection in Canada and holdings in the United States contributed to performance.

The fixed income portion of the Fund outperformed the fixed income index, with a shorter duration contributing to performance. Security selection in federal bonds and in corporate bonds in the energy sector also contributed. Conversely, the portfolio's allocation across maturities detracted from performance as the yield curve flattened. Underweight exposure to provincial bonds also detracted.

## Recent Developments

The portfolio management team responsible for asset allocation decisions in the Fund believes that the economy is approaching mid-cycle, having passed the peak rate of expansion and policy accommodation. The team therefore has more moderate expectations for growth as the market's long-term inflation expectations stabilize. Major central banks have begun tightening monetary policy, and decreasing fiscal support may also start slowing growth in consumer demand. However, the team believes the trillions in dollars of excess savings accumulated over multiple lockdowns could offset these drags on growth by allowing higher consumer and business spending.

The team believes that, although higher inflation is likely to persist for a few more quarters, the risk of persistent inflation will be reduced by tighter monetary policy and decreased fiscal support. The team believes an environment of strong growth with inflation expectations under control would be positive for risk assets, such as stocks.

Over the near term, the fixed income portfolio management team expects yields to gradually increase as the economy continues to recover. The team believes inflationary pressures will likely remain elevated due to global supply-chain disruptions. Further, interest rates are expected to increase toward the end of 2022 as the Bank of Canada winds down its asset purchase program. As such, the portfolio has maintained its shorter duration.

## Other Developments

Ongoing uncertainty regarding the duration and long-term impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and the implementation of vaccination programs, as well as the efficacy of government and central bank monetary and fiscal interventions, may continue to affect the Fund's performance in future periods.

IG CI Canadian Balanced Fund was merged into the Fund after the close of business on June 18, 2021, with securityholder investments being switched into this Fund on a tax-deferred basis. I.G. Investment Management, Ltd. does not consider this merger to be a material change for the Fund's investors.

Effective September 14, 2021, Wendy Rudd was appointed as a member of the IG Wealth Management Funds' Independent Review Committee.

## Related Party Transactions

I.G. Investment Management, Ltd. is the Manager, Trustee and Portfolio Advisor of the Fund. The Fund is offered through the Consultants of Investors Group Financial Services Inc. and Investors Group Securities Inc., together referred to as the Distributors. The Manager, Portfolio Advisor, Distributors and Trustee are, indirectly, wholly owned subsidiaries of IGM Financial Inc.

The following sub-advisor provided investment services to the Fund:

- Mackenzie Financial Corporation

Mackenzie Financial Corporation is a wholly owned subsidiary of IGM Financial Inc.

The Fund paid a management fee to the Manager and Portfolio Advisor for management and portfolio advisory services (see *Management Fees*).

The Fund also paid the Manager an administration fee and in exchange the Manager paid the operating costs and expenses of the Fund, except for certain specified costs.

The Fund paid the Distributors a service fee as compensation for providing or arranging for the provision of services to the Fund, including the issue or allotment of securities. A portion of the service fee for Series C and Tc is rebated by the Distributors to the Fund, for distribution to Series C and Tc securityholders quarterly, as outlined in the Prospectus.

The Trustee is responsible for the overall direction of the affairs of the Fund. The Fund paid the Trustee a fee for its services.

See *Series Information* for the annual rates paid by each series (as a percent of average net assets) for these fees.

Securityholders in Series Tu and U also pay an advisory fee directly to the Distributors. This fee is not included in the Fund's expenses.

During the period, the Fund invested in other funds also managed by the Manager or affiliates of the Manager. The Manager relied on standing instructions approved by the IG Wealth Management Funds Independent Review Committee for the execution of all such transactions.

Investment, if any, in unlisted open-ended funds managed by the Manager and/or affiliates of the Manager will be in series that do not pay fees. The exchange-traded funds (ETFs) into which the Fund may invest may have their own fees and expenses which reduce the value of the ETF. Generally, the Manager has determined that fees paid by an ETF are not duplicative with the fees paid by the Fund. However, where the ETF is managed by Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the ETF may distribute a fee rebate to the Fund to offset fees paid within the ETF.

During the period, the Fund received \$26,656 in income distributions from investments in ETFs managed by the sub-advisor to offset fees paid within the ETFs. There is no assurance that these distributions will continue in the future.

IGM Financial Inc. is a subsidiary of Power Corporation of Canada. Companies related to Power Corporation of Canada are therefore considered affiliates of the Manager. As at September 30, 2021, the Fund held the following investments in companies affiliated with the Manager: common shares of Power Corporation of Canada valued at \$9,003,722 and common shares of Great-West Lifeco Inc. valued at \$3,409,210. The Manager relied on the standing instructions approved by the IG Wealth Management Funds Independent Review Committee for investment in related issuers. These investments represented, in aggregate, 0.6% of the Fund's net assets.

The Manager relied on an approval issued by the IG Wealth Management Funds Independent Review Committee to proceed with the merger of IG CI Canadian Balanced Fund into the Fund on June 18, 2021.

Certain other investment funds, distributed by IG Wealth Management, and other qualified investors may invest in Series P or S of this Fund. As at September 30, 2021, these series comprised approximately 2.6% of the Fund's net assets. The Manager relied on standing instructions approved by the IG Wealth Management Funds Independent Review Committee for the execution of all such transactions, which are based on the net asset value per security determined in accordance with the stated policies of the Fund on each transaction day. Investments by other investment funds in the Fund increase the risk of large redemption or purchase orders, which could result in larger than normal cash positions in the Fund for short periods of time. This could have an impact on the Fund's operations. However, the Manager uses various strategies to minimize the potential dilutive impact associated with large cash positions. These strategies may include transferring securities in-kind where possible, utilizing ETFs to maintain market exposure in lieu of cash and spreading transactions in smaller increments over a period of time.

The Manager has an investment in the Fund which, at September 30, 2021, was \$976 for Series P, \$1,909 for Series T NL, \$1,378 for Series Tc and \$1,964 for Series T JNL.

## Management Fees

The Fund pays a management fee, and this fee, paid by each series, is calculated as a percentage of the net asset value of the series at the close of each business day (see *Series Information* for rates payable by each series). Generally, management fees pay the costs incurred to provide investment advisory and management services, as well as distribution-related services provided by the Distributors.

However, in the case of Series U and Tu, securityholders pay the Distributors an advisory fee (separate from the management fee) directly. Therefore, the management fee in those series is used for investment advisory and management services only.

For all other retail series (i.e. which excludes Series R, P and S, if issued), approximately 59% of management fees paid during the period was used for investment advisory and management services, and approximately 41% related to distribution-related services. This may vary by series.

- Effective June 30, 2012, the annual management fee rate for Series A and B decreased by 0.30% to 1.70% and for Series C the rate decreased by 0.10% to 1.90%.
- Effective June 30, 2012, the annual service fee rate for Series B decreased by 0.05% to 0.40%.
- Effective January 1, 2017, the annual management fee rate for Series Tu and U decreased by 0.10% to 0.60%.
- Effective January 1, 2017, the annual service fee rate for Series B, J NL, T NL and T JNL decreased by 0.10% to 0.30%.

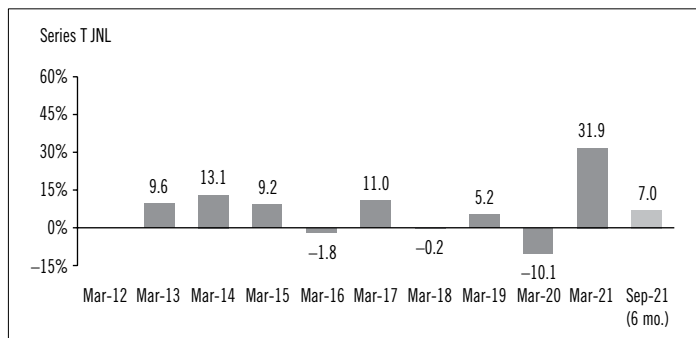
